Duncan Memorial United Methodist Youth

1. Youth are asked to adhere to The Golden Rule at all times and treat others as they would like to be treated. This includes the rights and opinions of all other youth and adults regardless of age, race or gender.
2. All youth are to respect the property of Duncan Memorial UMC, Randolph-Macon College, and any other property where the youth are meeting for service, mission or fellowship.
3. When an adult or youth is speaking everyone is expected to pay attention and behave in an appropriate manner.
4. There will be no smoking, drinking, or illegal drugs permitted at any youth activity sponsored by Duncan Memorial UMC on or off church grounds.
5. There will be no improper gestures or language used at any youth activity on or off church grounds. This includes any comments that would be hurtful when directed at a specific individual or group.
6. The use of electronic devices will be limited to travel time during trips.
7. Bathing suits are to be church appropriate. Speedo and skimpy bikinis are not allowed. One piece swimsuits and tankini styles are appropriate for young women.
8. Any youth acting improperly, not adhering to the rules, or creating a disturbance that effects the ability of others to listen and participate will be asked to call their parents/guardians to come pick them up. This includes activities away from church grounds and Randolph-Macon campus.
